MONTHLY ONLINE SUPERVISION FOR INCLUSION TEACHERS

The Group Supervision for the Inclusion Team (GSIT) is a small group of inclusion teachers that meet online via Zoom once a month with two Clinical Supervisors. The Clinical Supervisors are a practicing speech and language therapist and a psychologist at The LightHouse Arabia. Both supervisors have extensive experience in supporting and working collaboratively with SEN departments across different schools. The GSIT is a closed group, and the teachers can bring any topics or issues related to their practice as an inclusion teacher. Some of these topics relate to working with students, parents, and colleagues, as well as issues including, but not limited to, ethical dilemmas, caregiver burnout within the scope of personal and professional boundaries.

BENEFITS IN ATTENDING MONTHLY SUPERVISION

- To provide a **safe, supportive environment** where Inclusion Teachers (ITs) can share challenging cases and receive professional input from the supervisors as well as their peers.
- The group aims to provide a space where ITs can **reflect** on their role in the classroom and learn **practical tools** and techniques to further **enhance their practice**.
- The group can also provide the supervision to **challenge any unhelpful assumptions** and attitudes which may influence practice.
- Guidance on how to give **clear, concise feedback** to parents, classroom teachers and SENCOs as well as understanding the **clinical/appropriate language** when discussing the student.
- **Clarifying referral pathways** – identifying what kind of assessments are needed and ensuring referrals are made to appropriate professionals.
- Identifying behaviours commonly associated with various occurring clinical conditions such as ADHD, ASD, LDs, language impairments, etc.
- The opportunity to **share challenging cases and receive professional input** from the supervisor, as well as their peers.
- An opportunity to **reflect on their practice** as well as **factors that may impact on the ITs work in the classroom** including working relationships with colleagues within the scope of personal and professional boundaries.

LAYOUT OF SESSIONS
